Learning from the best

Gold Bond are full-service logistics providers, which means they service the entire supply chain, from the ports of Israel to the end customer. They also have a very broad client base, from very small individual importers, to very large ecommerce vendors.

They have been paying close attention to the successes of their biggest clients, and other ecommerce giants, in order to improve their own services and find solutions to their most common challenges. These are typical of large 3PL providers, and include:

- Seasonal peaks which put additional pressure on their services and staff
- Massive SKU proliferation, owed to their large variety of customers and offerings
- Fulfilling same day delivery throughout Israel





In a bid to answer these challenges, Gold Bond sought to partner with a company that could provide strong and reliable technology and innovative solutions. Always at the forefront, they became the first Israeli logistics provider to implement autonomous mobile robots (AMRs) in early 2020, facilitating an extremely efficient goods-to-person (GTP) picking and packing warehouse. Still, more was needed to reach the levels of productivity they aspired to.

A fully integrated system

As a major player in Israel's logistics community, Gold Bond needed to raise the bar by setting a new gold standard. This meant using a system that could adapt and scale to meet the client expectation to deliver, even during unprecedented global events. It was needed to bridge the gap between the client host systems - such as Shopify or WooCommerce - and their own. A fully integrated WMS was decided upon, to provide visibility and transparency across the entire chain.

The Körber WMS, which was implemented in just four months, was able to integrate several pick, putaway, sorting, loading, distribution and auditing interfaces together into one platform. These included:

- · Item master
- · Capture of hosts inbound orders detail
- Receipt export to real time adjust stock in host ERPs or eCommerce platforms directly.
- Capture of end customer outbound order detail from ERP of eCommerce platforms directly.
- Invoice export to make sure that the end customer is billed for the precise order details.
- · Orders status

From set up to going live with all solutions, including an existing traffic management system and new AMRs –took a total of 7 months. Fully implemented, it provided the visibility and transparency Gold Bond needed to optimize all processes, and in some cases, either partially or fully automate them.

- · Real-time stock and information transparency end-to-end
- Stock accuracy above 99.96%
- Throughput goals met (250 picks per hour per employee)

All of this was achieved with almost zero impact on Gold Bond's business during implementation. It has also helped them answer their bigger operational challenges – including fulfilling same day delivery across the whole of Israel, all while managing massive SKU proliferation and divided between different eCommerce clients.

Today, Gold Bond have almost 100 clients. This is a number that continues to grow, with systems and processes ready to handle even more.
